Prior to her current role, Monique has held a variety of positions in healthcare, including project management, consumer liaison, communications, and policy development.

Monique's background in working in consumer issues in the public health system began in 1990 working for National Women's and Green Lane Hospitals resolving consumer complaints following the recommendations arising from the Cartwright Enquiry. This passion for patient rights and service improvement has continued on into her current role as the Chairperson for the CMDHB Community Panel since its inception in 2005.
